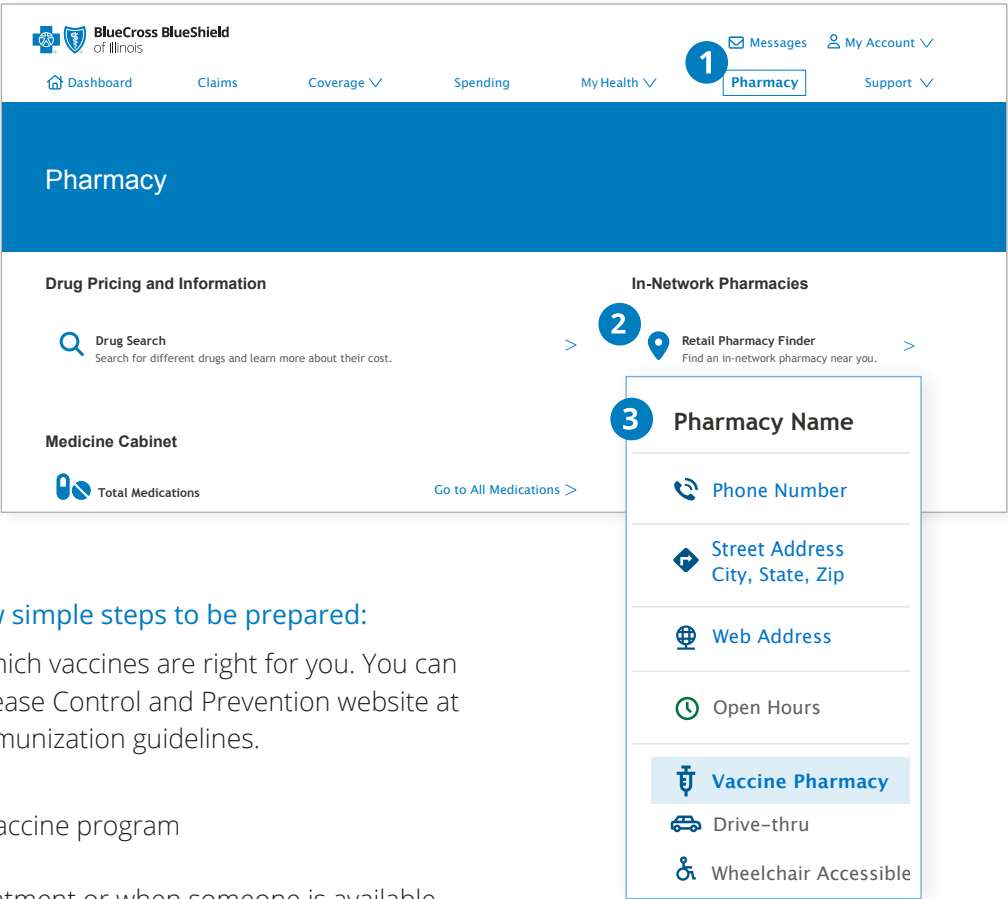
Easy Access to Vaccinations Near You

Getting vaccinated at a participating pharmacy in your area can be a simple and convenient part of your health care routine. BCBSIL's vaccine network has many national and regional chains and independent pharmacies that can give vaccines in the store.

To find a participating pharmacy:

- 1 Log in to your member account at bcbsil.com or on the BCBSIL app and select the **Pharmacy** tab.
- 2 Click on **Retail Pharmacy Finder** and enter your zip code.
- 3 Click on a pharmacy to see if vaccines are available at that location.

You may also call the number on your member ID card for help finding a pharmacy in the vaccine network near you.



Before You Go

Before getting a vaccine, take a few simple steps to be prepared:

- Ask your doctor or pharmacist which vaccines are right for you. You can also visit the U.S. Centers for Disease Control and Prevention website at cdc.gov/vaccines/by-age for immunization guidelines.
- Call the vaccine pharmacy to:
 - Verify they participate in the vaccine program
 - Check if the vaccine is in stock
 - Find out if you need an appointment or when someone is available to give the vaccine

Remember to hand your member ID card to the pharmacist when you visit a participating pharmacy to get a vaccination. The pharmacist will submit a claim and collect any copays, if necessary.

Vaccine coverage may vary based on your benefit plan. Check your plan materials or call the number on your member ID for more details. Restrictions or other requirements may apply.

If you are a member whose prescription drug plan is not administered through BCBSIL or coverage for these vaccinations are not included in your plan, please contact your employer group benefits administrator for information about the availability and coverage of vaccinations under your plan.
